\$5,500

Fence Line - Provide 100 linear feet of fence line around outdoor play areas and gross motor spaces. Fence line is critical for the safety of our children as I-70 is immediately behind the building. These important gifts will be recognized with a special tag placed on the fence line of play area. We need a total of 1630 linear feet of fencing to make this building safe for our learners, a total of \$89,650. (16 available).

\$10,000

Hallway Sensory Murals - Provide tactile and visual sensory experiences, allowing our students and clients to engage in calming activities or sensory integration play while in transition from one area of the building to another. Recognition will occur at the mural site. (2 available)

\$15,000

15th Anniversary Gift - Honor Bridgeway Academy's first 15 years, while helping us ensure learning opportunities for all over 15 years and beyond. All gifts of \$15,000 or more will be recognized on the donor wall in the lobby of our new building.



\$20,000

Board Room - A professional meeting space that will be utilized for public-facing meetings, including meetings of Bridgeway Academy's Board of Trustees and committees. (1 available)

\$25,000

Sensory Room - Designed to include as many sensory experiences as possible,

sensory rooms create calming environments and are an important therapeutic tool and a highly motivating space for Bridgeway Academy students. (4 available)

Family Retreat – Provide a place where the parents, siblings, and caregivers of our students and clients can find a place to work, read, or visit. (1 available)

Staff Retreat - Bridgeway Academy's staff deserves a place where they can experience wellness and restoration. This is hard work, and each and every day they show up and give our students and clients their absolute best. The retreat will include quiet spaces for study, work out equipment, and a private shower. (1 available)

\$30,000

Classroom Equipment – Help us outfit our 29 classrooms (ranging from Pre-K through 12th grade) for Bridgeway Academy's learners. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur on signage at the classroom entryway. (29 available)

Classroom Technology - Help us outfit three of our nine new classrooms with critical technology like Smartboards, Chromebooks and iPads. Recognition will occur directly on or next to technology purchases in addition to the donor wall. (3 available)

Program Pods - Program Pods provide efficient and beautiful work space for Bridgeway Academy's leadership teams. These small meeting spaces, private work spaces and rooms are designed for collaboration and parent support. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur on signage at the Program Pod entryway. (2 available)

Training Room - Used for staff training, professional development, Family Partnership parent trainings, workshops, and community meetings, the Training Room is a perfect space for learning and teaching with state-of-the-art technology. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur on signage at the Training Room's entryway. (1 available)

Psychological Services Treatment Spaces - Bridgeway Academy's Psychological Services require private meeting rooms and quiet testing spaces as well as small group meeting space. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur on signage at the entryway. (2 available)

\$40,000

Primary Playground & Garden – Help us install new and existing age-appropriate play equipment, raised beds for educational gardens and a track for bikes, trikes, walking

and running. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur on signage within the play space. (1 available)

Secondary Playground & Garden - Help us install new swings and other new and existing age-appropriate play equipment as well as educational and therapeutic gardens for the Secondary program. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur on signage within the play space. (1 available)

\$50,000

Indoor Play and Flex Spaces - These large, flexible spaces will accommodate play and gross motor activities when weather keeps us indoors as well as age-appropriate spaces for our before and aftercare programs. From arts and crafts to group play or occupational and physical therapy work, these spaces offer students and staff lots of flexibility. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur at the entry way. (2 available)

Occupational Therapy Treatment Spaces - From play spaces to table work, tying shoes to typing on a keyboard, Occupational Therapists help children master the activities of daily living. Recognition will occur at the entrance way of the suite as well as on the donor wall. (2 available)

Speech Therapy Treatment Spaces - Speech therapists work with individuals individually, in small groups and collaboratively with other therapy disciplines. The three treatment spaces and office group will provide therapists with plenty of private work spaces and treatment spaces. Recognition will occur at the entrance way of the suite as well as on the donor wall. (3 available)

Physical Therapy Treatment Spaces - Swings, therapy balls, scooters and bucket bridges - physical therapy spaces are big and filled with lots of equipment that must also be age and size appropriate. While these spaces look fun, our students work hard to master their physical therapy goals. Recognition will occur at the entrance way of each space as well as on the donor wall. (3 available)

Music Therapy Treatment Spaces - The music therapy department works with students 1:1 and in small and large group settings. There are drum sets, and ukuleles and pianos, and dancing and inspiration. Recognition will occur at the entrance way of each space as well as on the donor wall. (2 available)

\$100,000

Life Skills Center - Bridgeway Academy's Life Skills Center provides our students the opportunity to practice and master daily living skills. From making a bed and washing dishes to cooking and cleaning, the Life Skills Center offers many

opportunities for learning. In addition to the donor wall, recognition will occur at the entrance way to the Life Skills Center. (1 available)

Vocational Skills Center - The ability to practice and master vocational skills at Bridgeway Academy provides opportunities for future independence. Bridgeway Academy's Vocational Skills program houses a kitchen to practice culinary skills; technology for working on computer and office skills and is the home to our vocational skills curriculum. Recognition will occur at the entrance to the Vocational Skills Center as well as on the donor wall. (1 available)

\$250,000

Gymnatorium - From gross motor and play space to a large special event space for everything from Theater Group performances to annual fundraising events, the gymnatorium is a versatile space for students, staff and the community. Recognition will occur at the gymnatorium entry way as well as on the donor wall. (1 available)

Main Lobby and Entryway - Front-facing and beautiful, Bridgeway Academy's entrance and lobby will be warm and welcoming with friendly faces and restful spaces. Recognition will occur in the lobby and on the donor wall. (1 available)

\$500,000

Building Wings: Pre-K & K, School-Aged, Middle School, High School - Sensory pathways, visual wayfinding, our building wings are designed with the age and needs of our students. Recognition will be placed in each wing and on the donor wall. (4 available)
